In 2024, we look forward to continuing our partnerships with nonprofits, telling their unique stories, and, of course, raising more money!

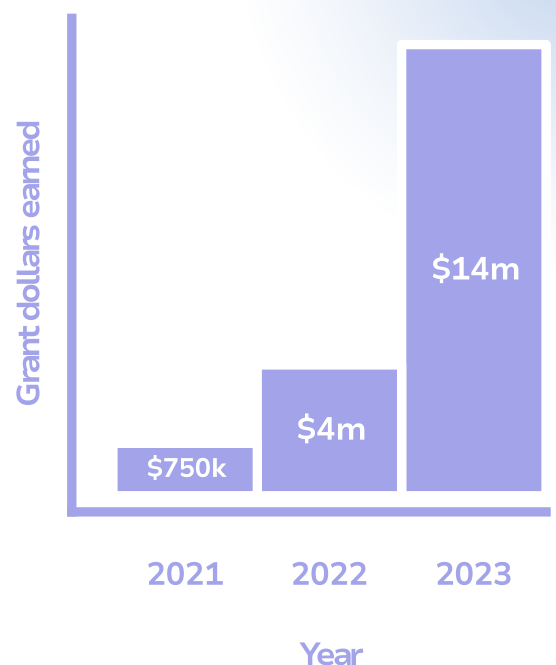

How We Helped

Scribe helped **250+ nonprofits** through our custom grant services and grant training workshops.
